

## AS WE GATHER

On this Holy Trinity Sunday, we do not so much explain God as confess Him. We testify to Him who has revealed Himself to us. To the mind in search of reasonable answers, God will always be a question or riddle to be solved. But to the empty heart, the Holy Spirit leads us to see with faith the God whose majesty has worked for our salvation and whose mercy has rescued us sinners from sin and the grave. Like Nicodemus of old, we want to know how, yet our Lord gives us not the how, but the who; not the explanation, but the mystery of mercy big enough to save us. We come today confessing with our fathers in faith the Athanasian Creed, singing “Holy, Holy, Holy,” and rejoicing in the God who is bigger than we are, but who becomes one of us to save us.

INVOCATION

Pastor: In the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

People: **Amen.**

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

Pastor: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

People: **But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

*Silence for meditation and reflection.*

Pastor: Let us then confess our sins to God our Father.

People: **Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.**

Pastor: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

People: **Amen.**

## CREED

*Athanasian Creed (Part 1)*

Pastor: Whoever desires to be saved must, above all, hold the catholic faith.

People: **Whoever does not keep it whole and undefiled will without doubt perish eternally.**

Pastor: And the catholic faith is this,

People: **that we worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the substance.**

Pastor: For the Father is one person, the Son is another, and the Holy Spirit is another.

People: **But the Godhead of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit is one: the glory equal, the majesty coeternal.**

Pastor: Such as the Father is, such is the Son, and such is the Holy Spirit:

People: **the Father uncreated, the Son uncreated, the Holy Spirit uncreated;**

Pastor: the Father infinite, the Son infinite, the Holy Spirit infinite;

People: **the Father eternal, the Son eternal, the Holy Spirit eternal.**

Pastor: And yet there are not three Eternals, but one Eternal,

People: **just as there are not three Uncreated or three Infinites, but one Uncreated and one Infinite.**

Pastor: In the same way, the Father is almighty, the Son almighty, the Holy Spirit almighty;

People: **and yet there are not three Almighty, but one Almighty.**

Pastor: So the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God;

People: **and yet there are not three Gods, but one God.**

Pastor: So the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord;

People: **and yet there are not three Lords, but one Lord.**

## SALUTATION & PRAYER OF THE DAY

Pastor: The Lord be with you.

People: **And also with you.**

Pastor: Let us pray.

People: **Almighty and everlasting God, You have given us grace to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity by the confession of a true faith and to worship the Unity in the power of the Divine Majesty. Keep us steadfast in this faith and defend us from all adversities; for You, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, live and reign, one God, now and forever. Amen.**

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE DAY

Pastor: Today is Holy Trinity, the First Sunday after Pentecost. The festival half of the Church Year, which has confessed the saving events in the life of our Lord, now gives way to that part of the Church Year in which we hear His teaching. From the Old Testament Reading from Deuteronomy 6, we hear the “Shema”, the first and shortest Trinitarian Creed. In the Epistle from Romans, we hear St. Paul’s beautiful doxology, praising our Three-in-One God. In the Gospel according to John, we hear Jesus’ conversation with Nicodemus and within this we hear the most beloved and familiar verse of Scripture.

#### OLD TESTAMENT READING

*Deuteronomy 6:1-5*

Leader: This is the Word of the Lord.

**People: Thanks be to God.**

#### PSALM

*Psalm 29*

Leader: Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings,

**People: ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.**

Leader: Ascribe to the LORD the glory due His name;

**People: worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness.**

*Men: The voice of the LORD is over the waters;  
the God of glory thunders,  
the LORD, over many waters.  
The voice of the LORD is powerful;  
the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.*

*Women: The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars;  
the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon.  
He makes Lebanon to skip like a calf,  
and Sirion like a young wild ox.*

*Men: The voice of the LORD  
flashes forth flames of fire.  
The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness;  
the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.*

Leader: This is the Word of the Lord.

**People: Thanks be to God.**

Leader: The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the 3rd chapter.

**People: Glory to You, O Lord.**

**GOSPEL READING**

*John 3:1-17*

Leader: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**People: Praise to You, O Christ.**

**CREED**

*Athanasian Creed (Part 2)*

Pastor: Just as we are compelled by the Christian truth to acknowledge each distinct person as God and Lord, so also are we prohibited by the catholic religion to say that there are three Gods or Lords.

**People: The Father is not made nor created nor begotten by anyone.**

Pastor: The Son is neither made nor created, but begotten of the Father alone.

**People: The Holy Spirit is of the Father and of the Son, neither made nor created nor begotten, but proceeding.**

Pastor: Thus, there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.

**People: And in this Trinity none is before or after another; none is greater or less than another;**

Pastor: but the whole three persons are coeternal with each other and coequal, so that in all things, as has been stated above, the Trinity in Unity and Unity in Trinity is to be worshiped.

**People: Therefore, whoever desires to be saved must think thus about the Trinity.**

Pastor: Grant to us grace, O Lord, that knowing Your goodness in creation, we use Your gifts wisely and for the benefit of all people and bring to You the tithes and offerings of a grateful heart.

**People: Grant to us grace, O Lord, to remember those who went before us with the sign of faith and now rest from their labors, and guide us that we faithfully confess Your name until we join them in Your nearer presence forevermore.**

Pastor: Grant to us grace, O Lord, that we find contentment of heart and that we know the riches of Your mercy as our greatest treasure in life and our hope in death.

**People: Blessed be the kingdom of our God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit,**

**All: Blessed be His kingdom, now and forever, to the end of all the ages!**

## CREED

## *Athanasian Creed (Part 3)*

- Pastor: But it is also necessary for everlasting salvation that one faithfully believe the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- People: Therefore, it is the right faith that we believe and confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is at the same time both God and man.**
- Pastor: He is God, begotten from the substance of the Father before all ages; and He is man, born from the substance of His mother in this age:
- People: perfect God and perfect man, composed of a rational soul and human flesh;**
- Pastor: equal to the Father with respect to His divinity, less than the Father with respect to His humanity.
- People: Although He is God and man, He is not two, but one Christ:**
- Pastor: one, however, not by the conversion of the divinity into flesh, but by the assumption of the humanity into God;
- People: one altogether, not by confusion of substance, but by unity of person.**
- Pastor: For as the rational soul and flesh is one man, so God and man is one Christ,
- People: who suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again the third day from the dead,**
- Pastor: ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, God Almighty, from whence He will come to judge the living and the dead.
- People: At His coming all people will rise again with their bodies and give an account concerning their own deeds.**
- Pastor: And those who have done good will enter into eternal life, and those who have done evil into eternal fire.
- People: This is the catholic faith; whoever does not believe it faithfully and firmly cannot be saved.**
